Please note that all bulls this year must be tested BVD-PI negative along with all of the other health requirements that are listed in the rules & regulations. Genetic defect status will be noted in the catalog, but should not in and of itself preclude a bull from selling.

RULES & REGULATIONS FOR BULLS

1. **Date of Sale:** February 6, 2010.
2. **Place of Sale:** Klamath County Fairgrounds.
3. **Terms of Sale:** Cash.
4. **Bidding:** This sale is without reserve or pass-out, provided however the right to bid is reserved for all consignors and their agent, unless otherwise announced. Each animal will be sold to the highest bidder without reserve. There will be no by-bidding. Any phone or mail bids to the auctioneer or ring men will be announced when bull is sold. The auctioneer in charge will settle any disputes as to bids, and his decision on such matters will be final.
5. **Entry Fees and Selling Commission:** *Halter Bulls: Entry fee of \$60.00 per head for OCA members; \$75 per head for non members. Penned Bulls: \$100.00 per head for OCA member; \$115 per head for non members, plus a commission of 7% of the gross sale will be charged each consignor per head.* Entry fees must be paid by November 15, 2009 and are not refundable under any condition unless a bull is pre-sifted by sale management. Copies of registration certificates should be included with your entry form, along with a signed copy of the rules & regulations. Any entry received after November 15, 2009 may be listed in a sub-catalog. Substitute bulls and late entries received after November 15, 2009 will be charged an additional \$50.00 handling fee per animal.
6. **Age of Bulls of All Breeds:** Bulls must have been born by December 1, 2008 (14 months) and after December 1, 2007 (26 months).
7. **Ownership of Bulls:** All bulls must have been originally registered in the consignor's name or transferred to the consignor on or before the sale. Proof of ownership will be required for bulls prior to selling. **Transportation slips** must be provided on bulls coming from within Oregon. **Brand inspections** must be provided on any bull which is not branded with the consignor's brand, showing transfer of ownership, and also on bulls coming from out-of-state.
8. **Substitute Bulls:** A bull may only be substituted for a bull of the same breed.
9. **Bull Registration:** Only bulls registered by their respective breed association will be accepted.
10. **BULLS:** **Halter Bulls:** Will be tied and must be broke to lead.
Penned Bulls: *CAN NOT* be haltered or fitted during the sale. Bulls that are fitted in the penned section will be asked to move to the haltered section.
11. **Stall Assignments:** A barn manager will assist you upon arrival. Please call ahead of time if there is another consignor you would like to be tied or penned by- we will do our best to accommodate those needs.
12. **Arrival of Bulls:** Bulls must be at the Fairgrounds and all paperwork turned in to the sale office by 5:00 p.m., Wednesday, February 3rd, 2010.
13. **Grooming of Animals:** Since freezing weather can prevent use of the wash racks, the washing facilities may not be available. It is suggested that consignors wash bulls before leaving home. We recommend that you bring a generator if you have one.
14. **Health Requirements:**

Brucellosis- tests are required on all bulls. Negative blood tests required on all bulls within 60 days prior to the sale and before arrival in Klamath Falls to facilitate interstate movement after the sale.

Trichomoniasis - Each individual health certificate must have a signed veterinarian's statement that the bull has been tested for Trichomoniasis within sixty days of the sale date by culture of an appropriate preputial sample. Please include a copy of the culturing la or veterinarians actual day to day test results. Bulls infected with Trichomoniasis will not be sold.

PI-BVD - All bulls must have a negative PI-BVD test by an approved laboratory (not a herd test). A copy of the results must be included with entry.

All bulls must have individual health certificates which will be mailed to you by December 1, 2009. Additionally, all bulls originating outside of Oregon require a complete Interstate Health Certificate. The health papers should be completed by your veterinarian at the time of semen testing. These must be completed, not to get the bulls to Klamath Falls, but so they are ready to go to any area with the purchaser.

All bulls must be vaccinated (not more than 60 days or less than 30 days before the Sale) for: Redwater, Black leg, Malignant edema, Clostridium sordelli, Clostridium novyi, Clostridium perferingens C & D, Leptospirosis 5; IBR; Pasteurella and Haemophilus.

Even if bulls have had vaccinations as a calf, these are still required.

15. **Semen Test:** Bulls must be semen tested within sixty (60) days of the sale and must be designated as a Satisfactory Potential Breeder, with a scrotal circumference of not less than 34 centimeters, by a licensed veterinarian or CSS technician.
16. **Minimum Weight Per Day Requirement:** Bulls will be required to meet minimum weight per day of age. This will be used only to qualify for the sale. (1017 pounds up to 14 months of age plus 1.1 pounds per day thereafter.) Bulls will be weighed Thursday, February 4th, 2010, beginning at 9:00 a.m.
17. **Rules on Sifting:** The Sale Committee reserves the right to bar any bull from selling through the ring which shows any defect or disease, infection, or unsoundness, or overfitting which may limit its usefulness. An examination of each bull will be made by a veterinarian and two experienced cattle operators. This will serve as a means of detecting such bulls. Judging and sifting will begin at 9:00 a.m. on Friday, February 5, 2010. All bulls will be graded for quality by a grader and two commercial cattlemen. The bulls must grade 87 or above to be eligible to sell through the sale. All bulls will be graded individually. Warts and ringworm are considered communicable diseases and will be sifted from the Sale.
18. **Sifted Bulls:** All bulls barred from the sale through the ring for reasons mentioned above may be sold at private treaty. In such an event the Sale Committee will not accept any responsibility for the future condition or performance of such animals.
19. **Liability:** Although every possible precaution will be exercised to protect the safety and comfort of guests of the sale, neither the Association nor its representatives, nor the auctioneers or clerks, assume any liability for accidents. All warranties are made between buyer and seller, not the sale management.
20. **Purchaser's Risk:** Each animal will be at purchaser's risk as soon as sold.
21. **Delivery of Bulls:** Free delivery will be made for any one buyer purchasing 5 or more bulls going to one location up to a distance of 200 miles. Delivery is at buyer's risk.
22. **Rule on All Non-Breeding Bulls:** Bulls must be semen tested. However, buyers suspecting a bull purchased at Klamath Falls to be an unsatisfactory potential breeder must notify the Klamath Bull Sale Committee regarding such a bull WITHIN FOURTEEN DAYS OF THE DATE OF THE SALE. The Committee will then have an examination and investigation made by a competent veterinarian. The Committee reserves the right to call in their own veterinarian if they deem it necessary. The Committee will consider exceptional cases. If it is determined that the bull is a non-breeder, consignor will be required to either compensate the buyer for the difference between beef value of the bull and the purchase price, or return the entire purchase price to the buyer and take the bull back at his own expense. If the buyer wishes a replacement and consignor is willing to settle in this manner, it will be satisfactory to the Bull Sale Committee.
23. **Pre-Sift:** Sale Management has the right to pre-sift entries prior to cataloging. If a bull is pre-sifted, that bull's entry fees will be returned to that consignor.
