Please accept this invitation to participate in our 50<sup>th</sup> Annual Klamath Bull and Horse Sale.

This is a select sale for working ranch and performance type horses. Registered and grade geldings and Registered AQHA and APHA mares three years of age thru twelve years of age may enter.

Horses will be thoroughly inspected by a sifting committee and veterinarians. Each horse will be inspected for soundness, conformation, disposition, conditioning, training and suitability for ranch work.

Please find the enclosed 2010 entry form and the rules and regulations for the sale that need to be signed and returned with the entry form. Entries need to be submitted and paid by November 15, 2009. Enclosed you will find a tentative schedule and entry form for the Stock Horse Challenge. This year, we have \$1,000.00 added money for the high marking sale horse in the Snaffle Bit and Bridal Class Sale Horse Challenge. We are also offering a Ranch Horse Class and Open Snaffle/Hackamore and Bridle Class.

To celebrate our 50<sup>th</sup> Anniversary we are having a Ranch Rodeo that will start Saturday night and finish Sunday. If you would like entries for this event please contact us...this will be limited to the first 20 paid teams!!

**RULES & REGULATIONS FOR HORSES**

1. **Date of Sale:** February 6, 2010, horses must be on grounds by 3:00 pm Thursday February 4<sup>th</sup>.
2. **Place of Sale:** Klamath County Fairgrounds.
3. **Completed entry form, including original registration papers, signed transfer certificates and entry fee of \$140.00 must be postmarked November 15, 2009. Commission of 10% of the gross sale will be charged each consignor per head. A late fee of \$100.00 will be charged for any entry not received by that date and may not be included in catalog.**
4. **Terms of Sale:** Cash. Consignor agrees that checks may be accepted for consignments, it being understood and agreed that the sale management assumes no responsibility for collection of said checks other than the presentment to the drawee for payment.
5. **Consignments of registered or grade geldings and registered AQHA or APHA mares are eligible.** A consignor may enter **one or more mares or one or more geldings or both.** All horses must be three years and not over twelve years of age at sale time- age will be based on a January 1<sup>st</sup> birthdate. **DEADLINE FOR ENTRIES AND PAYMENT IS November 15, 2009.** All registration papers must be in the name of the consignor. **No second-party transfers will be allowed.** Entered horses must match the description on the registration papers and entry forms.
6. **The consignor** warrants and represents to any subsequent purchaser that the seller has absolute, unencumbered and complete title to the accepted animal described on the entry form, and that he will forever warrant and defend said title against any person whomever.
7. **The consignor** agrees that should any cloud or encumbrance on title be suffered or permitted the seller will at once discharge, satisfy and completely dispose thereof.
8. **Bidding:** This sale is without reserve or pass-out; however the right to bid is reserved for all consignors and their agent, unless otherwise announced. With regard to repurchasing, the consignor or his agent may have the final successful bid and must sign the ticket indicating the sale as a repurchase. Once the auctioneer's gavel falls, title to the animal passes to the successful bidder. Consignors of repurchased animals are responsible for payment of the sales commission of ten percent. If there is a Reserve Bid, please fill in the amount on the entry form. Each animal will be sold to the highest bidder and the auctioneer will settle any bidding dispute and his decision shall be final.
9. Sale management has the right to pre-sift entries prior to cataloging. If a horse is pre-sifted, that horses' entry fee will be returned to the consignor.
10. All horses selling as registered animals must have a registration number. All geldings must have been gelded at least 60 days prior to the sale. Mares must have been pregnancy checked and found open within 60 days of the sale with a veterinary certificate to that effect.
11. **No refund of entry fee** will be made on horses accepted for cataloging or that are sifted from the sale.
12. All horses can be shown in the Stock Horse Challenge on Friday, February 5<sup>th</sup> at 12:00 and **MUST** be previewed at 9:00 on Saturday February 6<sup>th</sup>, 2010. The high marking horse in the Sale Horse Challenge will receive a cash bonus of \$1,000 after they sell. The Champion Stock Horse and Champion Confirmation Horse will be announced at sale time.

13. The following rules will govern the way in which all horses are to be inspected by the Sifting Committee. All horses passed by the Sifting Committee must sell and all decisions from the Committee are final.
- A. All horses will be checked in and paint branded with a number on Thursday February 4, 2010 at 3:00 pm.
  - B. All horses will be inspected for visible soundness, quality, condition, and suitability prior to the sale by the sifting committee and veterinarian on Friday, February 5, 2010 at 9:00 am. Horses will be required to drag a log, and open and shut a gate.
  - C. Only horses visibly sound in eyes, wind and limbs, as determined by the committee veterinarian, will be sold. No parrot mouthed (1/3 of a tooth) horses will be sold. All horses showing the effects of drugs or medication will be automatically sifted from the sale.
  - D. All horses may have blood drawn by the Committee Veterinarian. Blood samples will be used if needed for any reason.
  - E. All horses will be shown at halter before the sifting committee.
  - F. Handlers will move their horses in a manner prescribed by the sifting committee.
  - G. All horses will be required to load into a standard stock trailer in front of the sifting committee. Those horses failing to load easily will be announced at the auction.
  - H. All horses must demonstrate that all four feet can be easily picked up and handled.
  - I. All horses will be saddled and bridled in front of the sifting committee. Horses are required to be ridden, shown and sold with both a front and rear cinch. Handlers will then show their horses under saddle to the best of their advantage.
  - J. **All horses must be recently shod or trimmed.**
  - K. The committee reserves the right to sift horses at any time when they are being shown in addition to the original sifting up to the time of the sale. All horses will sell in the same equipment in which they are shown.
  - L. There will be no body clipping horses except ears, nose, jaw, fetlocks and manes.
  - M. All horses must work in the preview on Saturday, February 6<sup>th</sup>, 2010 at 9:00. Each horse must work a dry pattern and demonstrate they can go into the cattle pen quietly and move cattle out or around the pen with no excitement.
14. **TRANSFER OF OWNERSHIP:** All horses must be entered in the name of the owner as it appears on the registration paper. **NO DOUBLE TRANSFERS WILL BE ACCEPTED!!!** Allow time for the transfer of ownership prior to the sale. Private treaty sales of sifted horses must be made through the Sale Office. No papers will be released from the Horse Sale Office on any horse. Papers on sifted and/or no sale horses will be mailed back to the owner. Papers on sold horses will be mailed to the buyers after the sale or as soon as the check clears the bank.
15. **COGGINS TEST:** All horses must have a current Cog gins Test. No testing will be done at the Sale. Blood tests are run at the State Lab and require one to two weeks to get results. **NO PHOTOCOPIES OF RESULTS WILL BE ACCEPTED.** All horses passed by the committee must sell on Saturday afternoon, February 6, 2010 at the conclusion of the Bull Sale. **All horses should be current with their immunizations including West Nile and Tetanus.**
16. **Liability:** Consignor understands and agrees that the sale management, auctioneer, or employees of the sale will not be held responsible for any accident that may occur to horses, personnel, or persons attending the sale or for loss of any kind to horses or equipment through any cause, including fire, theft or injury. Consignor further understands that the committee will provide stalls for the animals, but that the consignor is responsible for their care, custody and control until delivered to a buyer, at which time the buyer will assume that responsibility. Although every possible precaution will be exercised to protect the safety and comfort of guests to the sale, neither the sale management nor its representatives, nor the auctioneers or clerks, assume any liability for accidents.
17. All warranties are made between buyer and seller, not the sale management. Each animal will be at purchaser's risk as soon as sold.

3. Negative Coggins Test and health certificate.
4. Brand Inspection required on all out of state horses, except California.
5. Transportation slips required for all horses.
6. Bill of Sale on all branded horses will be required from the brand owner.
